## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Open to amateur women golfers who have a USGA/Sun Country handicap index.
- The maximum handicap to which a competitor can compete is 40.4 per USGA Guidelines.
- Entry fee includes green fees, cart, range balls, prizes, and lunch after play on Day 3.
- Champions for both the AWGC and the NM/West Texas Women's Amateur will be crowned.
- Eligibility for the AWGC Champion: Must be a member of an Albuquerque metro area WGA & have a USGA/Sun Country handicap index.

## CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION – REGULAR FLIGHTS

- Three days (36 holes) of flighted competition.
- Flights will be determined by handicap index.

## CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION – SUPER SENIOR FLIGHT(S)

- Two days (36 holes) of flighted competition. Flights dependent on number of entries.
- Open to amateur women golfers who have a USGA/Sun Country Handicap index and are at least 65 years of age as of July 9, 2021.
- When signing up online for this flight please select the tournament named, “**NMWT Women's Amateur Championship-Super Senior.**”

## ENTRIES

- **Entry fee:** \$175 for 3-day competitors and \$120 for eligible 2-day competitors.

- **DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES and REFUNDS:** SCAGA will accept withdrawals up until the deadline for the Championship closes (Monday before Championship) with a cancellation fee of \$25. If you choose to withdraw after the deadline, there will be no refunds for any reason

Begins at 6:30 am on July 9, 2021 at Santa Ana Golf Club.

## Starting

Tee Times will be utilized for Days 1 & 2. Day 3 will be tee times or Shotgun start, dependent upon COVID restrictions that may be in place. TBD closer to the tournament dates.

### **Eligibility**

Participation is open to all amateur women golfers who have a USGA/Sun Country handicap index. The maximum handicap to which a competitor can compete is **40.4** per USGA guidelines. Flights will be determined by handicap index following the close of the entry deadline.

### **Entry/Cancellation Deadlines**

The Deadline for entries is July 5, 2020. The Committee reserves the right to admit additional players after July 6, 2020 if space is available.

### **Championship Awards**

The lowest total gross score in the **Championship Flight** for the three days of play will be declared the New Mexico – West Texas Women's Amateur Champion. In the event of a tie, the Champion will be determined by a sudden death playoff at a hole TBD immediately following regulation play. Prizes will be awarded for gross and net winners in the Championship flight and all other flights. In the event of a tie for any prizes other than the Champion, winners will be determined by a scorecard playoff working from hole #18 backwards of the courses played. Additionally, the lowest gross score in the Championship Flight that lives within the Albuquerque Metro Area, will be declared the Albuquerque Women's Golf Champion. In the event of a tie, the AWGC Champion will be determined by a sudden death playoff at a hole TBD immediately following regulation play.

### **Rules**

Play is governed by the 2019 USGA Rules of Golf, the SCAGA Hard Card, as well as the application of entry for the Championship, and where applicable, by the local rules and conditions of play received on the first tee at the Championship. Rules on the club scorecard should be disregarded.

### **Distance Measuring Devices**

In accordance with the USGA rules, devices that measure distance only may be used to determine distance. Please note that Santa Ana does not currently have GPS on their carts. Please note there are on-course yardage markers for 200, 150, and 100 yards from the center of the green.

### **Caddies**

Caddies will be allowed for this year's Championship.
